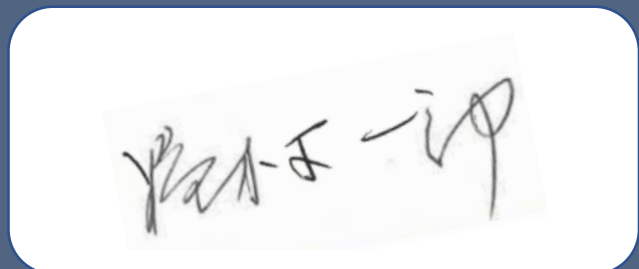

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## REPORT OF THE 14<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL MEETING OF THE COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE (CC)

Virtual - 22 November 2021

### 1. Opening of the meeting

The 14th Annual Meeting of the SEAFO Compliance Committee (CC) was convened on 22 November 2021 via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. The Chairperson, Mr Ichiro NOMURA from Japan, opened the meeting and welcomed the delegates. He gave a short introduction of himself since he is new to SEAFO.

### 2. Appointment of Rapporteur

The Executive Secretary was appointed as rapporteur for the 14<sup>th</sup> SEAFO CC meeting.

### 3. Adoption of agenda and meeting arrangements

The agenda was reviewed and adopted with no amendments ([Appendix I](#)).

Angola reiterated that meeting documents should be translated into Portuguese of high quality.

### 4. Introduction of Parties Delegations

Delegations introduced their members. See the delegate list in [Appendix II](#).

### 5. Introduction and admission of observers

No observers attended the meeting.

### 6. Executive Secretary's Report on Compliance

The Compliance Review Report was presented by the Executive Secretary (ES) ([DOC/CC/03/2021](#)). It was noted that in the report three fishing trips were included which took place from September 2020 to April 2021. The compliance review included three different vessels from two Contracting Parties. The number of sets, fishing days and catches have decreased compared to the previous review period.

The EU assured that in future all necessary reports would be provided by the deadlines as specified in the "SYSTEM".

Contracting parties and the ES will update the Authorised vessel list after CPs submitted the latest information.

The ES was tasked to find out about confidentiality of submitting port inspection reports to global platforms in the context of the Port State Control Measures and to report back to the next meeting.

**7. Consideration of the provisional SEAFO IUU Vessel list**

SEAFO has a joint listing agreement with NEAFC, NAFO, SIOFA and CCAMLR and the PROVISIONAL IUU Vessel list contains the latest updates ([DOC/CC/04/2021](#)), which the CC approved and recommended that the Commission accept the SEAFO IUU vessel list for 2022.

The CC noted and approved of the request from Bolivia to change the flag status of the FV Cape Flower to “unknown” since the vessel was deregistered by Bolivia on 30 January 2019.

Angola requested that the reference to Angola in the Northern Warrior found on the CCAMLR IUU vessel list should be removed since it is no longer under the Angolan flag. The CC agreed that the ES will write to the ES of CCAMLR to request for the appropriate changes to be made given the proof of deregistration provided by the Angolan party.

**ACTION:** The CC recommended to the Commission to accept the SEAFO IUU vessel list presented in [DOC/CC/04/2021](#).

**8. Venue and date of next meeting**

The next Compliance Committee meeting will coincide with the next Commission meeting and will therefore be decided in the Commission plenary session.

**9. Adoption of the Compliance Committee Report**

The meeting reviewed and adopted the Compliance Committee report to be presented by the Chair to the Commission.

**10. Closure of meeting**

The Chair closed the meeting at 12:51 on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021 and adjourned the meeting in good faith.
